HOW CAN YOU HELP!

The bedrock of our funding is our dedicated child sponsorship programme. By securing regular donations for each child we can confidently plan for the future.

We are extremely grateful for any donations of money or materials for our project.

Child Sponsorship

The present cost of providing education for a child in primary school is £300pa or £25.00pm. The cost for a child in senior school is £375pa or £31.25pm. This provides an opportunity to change the life of a child forever, develop a friendship with a particular child and provide much needed support for that child. You will normally receive a photograph, a personal history and letters from your sponsor child updating you on their progress.

Teacher Sponsorship

The average salary is £2,400pa (£200pm), which is well paid by Guatemalan standards. We feel that paying a decent wage sets a responsible example and will retain our best quality teachers. As with the child sponsorship you would receive regular correspondence from the teacher with their progress and the progress of their class. These sponsorships are vital to us as we attempt to increase the number of children we reach.

SOME SHOCKING STATISTICS

- In Guatemala almost 60% of children of school age do not attend school
- Only 5% of Guatemalan children enter high school
- Over 56% of Guatemalans live in poverty
- 24% of Guatemalans live on the equivalent of \$1 per day
- 49% of children under the age of 5 suffer from chronic malnutrition
- Infant mortality was 7 times higher in Guatemala than the UK in 2005.



This was the home of one of our students. Many of Our children live in conditions which are beyond our comprehension.

THE STORY so far.....

Since 2003 we have concentrated our efforts in the small town of Jocotenango and neighbouring village San Felipe. Where both our existing primary and secondary schools are located.

In 2008 we extended the numbers in our secondary school from 75 to 100 and we also inscribed a further 100 primary school children.

We also have 47 students studying in higher education. This makes the total being educated within the foundation 427 children. We hope to increase these figures in the future.
